Graffiti


Graffiti removal has taken place this year. Please see some before and after photos which were in our BID area.

Assault on officers

Three people have been arrested after two police officers were injured in West Bromwich on the morning of 21st July.

A Section 60, giving officers extra powers to carry out additional stop checks was granted, and had been live since 11am, for parts of West Bromwich

Police Update:

Just before 11.30am, officers were patrolling the town centre in New Square when they noticed two people acting suspiciously. When they approached the two men, they became aggressive and attacked our officers. The pair produced knives, and slashed at officers, before they were ultimately detained, with plain clothes police officers, New Square security officers and members of public all being of great assistance in detaining the pair. A woman who had been with the two offenders, who had attempted to make off, was also arrested shortly after. She has been released on bail as enquiries continue, with very

strict bail conditions. The two males were taken to custody, and were quickly charged with the attempted murder of the pair of officers. Additionally, the pair were charged with possession of an offensive weapon, possession of an imitation firearm, and a further charge of possession of a prohibited item. The pair are set to appear at Wolverhampton Crown Court in late August.

As for the two officers involved, both were treated at hospital for minor slash wounds, and have since fully returned to work. Both officers greatly appreciate the support and wellwishes they received from local businesses, members of public and their colleagues.

Guardian/robberies

Following weeks of investigation, two offenders suspected of carrying out a number of knife-point robberies in West Bromwich have been arrested. No further details can be provided at this time, but this is a great result for us, after a significant amount of hard work was put into identifying and apprehending them. The spate of knife-point robberies that they are suspected of carrying out had been one of the key reasons

why extra officers from Project Guardian have been present in the West Bromwich area, over the past few weeks.

Whilst the street robberies proved to be a major part of why Project Guardian officers were active in West Bromwich, further results that they have enjoyed in recent weeks have been profound. Along with their role in deterring to help prevent the street robberies, their proactive approach has resulted in the seizure of a number of vehicles,

along with confiscation of drugs, knives and other weapons.

Additionally, preparations are being made by Project Guardian and the local neighbourhood team to ensure a strong police presence around the town centre, once students return to college in September. This will involve regular patrols of ASB hotspots, along with routine weapon sweeps, proactive stop searches, intelligence-led operations and

The £25 million investment is subject to the submission and approval of final business cases.

We've redeveloped the outdoor market in West Bromwich with new stalls that include solar panels.


