**Re: M5 junction 1 to junction 2 routine maintenance work**

I'm writing to inform you of some upcoming maintenance work on M5, near Oldbury. This work will be carried out on our behalf by our contractor, Kier.

**What we're doing and why?**

We'll be carrying out routine maintenance work to the carriageway and overhead gantries on M5 between junction 1 and junction 2. The work has been identified following a recent inspection of this part of the network. The completed work will ensure we continue to provide a safer road to road users at all times.

**When will this work take place?**

Our work will start on 19 March, and run through until 14 April. We'll work overnight when traffic volumes are lower from 10pm to 6am, 7 nights a week. To reduce disruption further, our traffic management will be in place overnight as follows;

From 19 March to 1 April, **M5 northbound closed** between junction 2 and junction 1, 10pm to 6am.

From 2 April to 14 April, **M5 southbound closed** between junction 1 and junction 2, 10pm to 6am (excluding 8, 9 and 10 April).

**What does this mean for you**

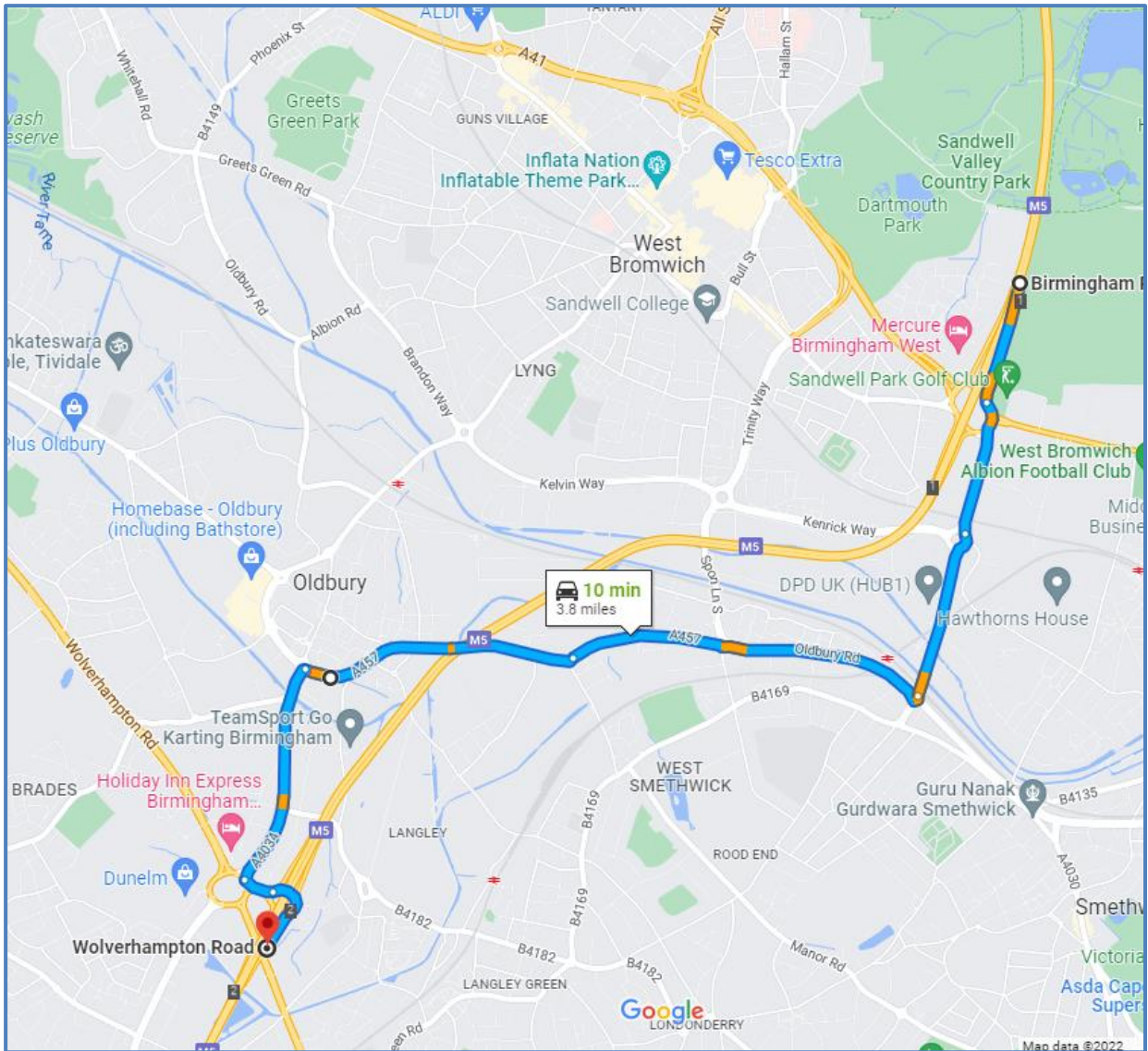
During closures, a fully signed diversion will be in place as below. Please allow additional time for your journey and plan ahead.

We'll make every effort to carefully manage noise and additional lighting whilst we work at this location to minimise the impact to local residents. We'll also aim to reopen the carriageway as soon as it is safe to do so.

A delayed start of work on 15 April from 11.30pm due to West Bromwich Albion playing a home game.

Our work is subject to change due to bad weather or any other unforeseen circumstances.

Access will be maintained throughout for the emergency services.
