Thank you for BID Ambassador Harvey for patrolling the area during storm Eunice to ensure everyone was safe. Our Ambassadors are in the area 6 days a week from 8.30am-5pm to provide assistance and update on existing and upcoming projects as well as keeping the public safe. If you have some time to spare and would like to get involved in patrols alongside s PCSO and/or an Ambassador please get in touch.

We are working hard to keep the Town Centre a safe place to live, shop and work. Over 60 local businesses are part of the town centre radio link which allows our businesses and key partners to communicate with each other directly. Each month we hold the Business Crime Reduction Partnership where the BID and partners discuss anything that may be negatively impacting our businesses. The free to download Disc security app is an online sharing system to share anything that may be beneficial for local businesses to know (however, please make sure all crime is reported via 101) and Pub/ Bet Watch enables licensed premises and betting agents to discuss any ASB on a quarterly basis.

In our latest communication with Sandwell Council we received an update of the latest Masterplan for the town centre regeneration. The plans are very ambitious and exciting and can be viewed at the council house or online. They outline the proposal to add a new town square for events, improved transport network, residential development, and green space integration. It is anticipated that over 1500 jobs will be created as a result.

Hopefully sunnier days are just around the corner and we would love to hear your ideas on any possible events to welcome visitors new and old and of course increase footfall. With the installation of hanging baskets and continuous weeding all year round, come spring we should have a colourful town centre.

Sandwell Council in conjunction with West Midlands Police and West Bromwich Business Improvement District will soon be introducing the Safe Spaces Scheme to the West Bromwich Town Centre.

his scheme will provide a safe place indoors for anyone who may feel vulnerable, distressed or worried while out and about in the West Bromwich Town Centre.

Safe Spaces are buildings such as shops, banks, libraries and other organization's where you can go if you feel unsafe outside while you call and wait for a family member or friend to collect you, for example, or for the police to arrive.

Organizations and businesses taking place in the Safe Spaces scheme can be identified by a Safe Space sticker displayed in their window.

Regeneration masterplan approved

mbitious plans to regenerate and revitalise West Bromwich town centre over the coming decades have been approved by Sandwell Council's Cabinet.

Regeneration bosses hope the masterplan will unlock further opportunities to boost the town's future economic growth and long-term prosperity.

Feedback from a public consultation showed there was overwhelming support for change with more than 80 per cent of respondents supporting the plan.

The masterplan underpins the projects already identified under the Town Investment Plan for West Bromwich. The plan includes a new Metro gateway, a town square for events, new green links, squares, parks and improvements to the sustainable transport network.

The council expects the masterplan to generate 1,359 homes, 1,740 jobs, new retail floor space, health, education and community uses and improved public transport accessibility.

The council expects the Masterplan to generate:

- 1,359 new homes;
- £6.6 million extra expenditure by new residents in West Bromwich;
- 1,740 new jobs;
- 12,000m2 of new retail floor space -replacing 30,000m2 of out-of-date and vacant retail floorspace;
- significant health, education and community uses;
- Improved public transport accessibility.

Urban Greening project

– update –

he West Bromwich Urban Greening project plans to deliver a number of initiatives over a five-year programme, to enhance existing green space and improve the appearance of West Bromwich town centre.

This will include the introduction of new trees, parklets (which include seating, plants and dining amenities) and play space. These will complement planned infrastructure works to establish better links from the town centre to Sandwell Valley.

The first instalment of funding has enabled the project to start landscape design work, undertake critical infrastructure surveys and progress to the final stage of detailed design of the scheme.

A condition survey is planned for the historic fountain and clock on Princess Parade. This will help understand the scope of the restoration and opportunities to introduce lighting to showcase these heritage assets.

A cultural programme will also be delivered

alongside the capital development works, including community involvement and artistic interpretation to help improve the physical and mental wellbeing of people. The cultural programme will start later this spring, following the successful appointment of a local provider.

The Urban Greening project is part of the Department for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities' Towns Fund investment programme for West Bromwich, with Sandwell Council, West Bromwich Business Improvement District (BID) and other partners working closely together on the details of the scheme.
