Current local policing priorities

COVID-19 | Under-25 Violence | Domestic Abuse

Firstly, I want to promote a number of engagement events which the officers and staff conduct on a regular basis –

- Coffee with a copper at West Bromwich Central Library
- Coffee with a copper at the 'Lets chat hub' located within the bus station.
- A crime prevention surgery in Queen Square
- A crime prevention surgery in New Square



All of the above and more are advertised on our twitter page (@ WestBromwichWMP) and we would love to see you there. Where able I would like to ask you to promote these events and please get in touch if you have any

ideas for future events. The good weather has finally arrived – hopefully to stay! so our intention is to hold more outside events in and around our open spaces.

The priorities for the town centre neighbourhood policing team remain the same and these are.

- 'Under 25 violence,'
- 'Street Drinker/ASB'
- 'Drugs.'

To keep you updated, the team have been focusing on these issues and recently obtained yet another CBO – Criminal behaviour order, this is an order which places restrictions on a person who has been causing anti-social behaviour in our town. We have also made a significant arrest – a male was arrested following intelligence being provided by local retailers where a significant amount of drugs were recovered, this person is now on bail and our investigation will continue at a fast pace.

I am pleased to say that the people I mentioned in my previous update who have been served with CBO's have all been adhering to their conditions which has reduced the number of calls regarding anti-social behaviour.

Unfortunately, a small minority of people who are visiting the town still behave in a manner which is not acceptable, and the team are really keen to ensure that this is prevented. The team continue to be supported by the Guardian Police patrols and other departments including WMP Dogs who conduct patrols during key times in the town, during lunch times and the end of school and college. Again, we have completed a number of stop and searches where appropriate and have identified and seized drugs and weapons.

I would like to ask that the members of our community continue to feed in intelligence so that we are able to act upon it. Intelligence can be submitted in a number of ways including in person to one of the officers patrolling the town, via 101, via email westbromtown@westmidlands. police.uk or anonymously via crime-stoppers – 'crimestoppers-uk.org' (0800 555 111)



I would also like to promote WMNOW – this is a free email messaging service from West Midlands Police. Sign up to receive updates straight into your inbox about crimes, police activity and other local news.

When you sign up you can let us know what topics you'd like to hear about – whether that's vehicle crime, burglaries or anti-social behaviour in your neighbourhood. You can also choose to receive updates from some of our partners including the fire service, Action Fraud and your local council. Remember to share our updates with your friends, family and neighbours to help keep our communities safe and connected.

Sprinklers are the most effective way to ensure that fires are suppressed or even extinguished before the fire service can arrive. They save lives and reduce injuries, protect firefighters who attend incidents, and reduce the amount of damage to both property and the environment from fire.





Urban Greening scheme nearing completion

Phase 1 of the West Bromwich High Street Urban Greening scheme is now complete and it's great to see people enjoying the new social/play spaces on 'Princess Parade Park'.

he light columns have now been repainted and feature artwork has been painted onto the light control boxes, adding more year round colour to the High Street.

Work is also nearing completion on Phase 2 of the scheme. This will see the opening of a 'Green Avenue' along Bull Street which will open up connectivity between Dartmouth Park, New Square Shopping Centre and the High Street. Hornbeam and maple trees have been planted along this corridor and new feature planting beds are also being created as part of the new public realm. These will be planted with bee/butterfly friendly plants, shrubs and grasses!

We are now looking forward to the GreenRoots Cultural Programme and activating these new spaces over the summer with art, cultural and storytelling around the nature in and around West Bromwich High Street. The first guided walk with the general public was a real success with a great morning of discussion in a Sunny West Brom!



Indoor Market – Planning application submitted

A planning application has been submitted for the new Indoor Market on Duchess Parade, West Bromwich. The proposals include an aspirational, fit-for-purpose home for market traders whilst also boosting the evening economy through a street food market offering a range of exciting new food choices in the middle of the town centre.

A decision is expected in June.

Sandwell Mechanical Engineering Centre

Contractors have been on site since November 2022, preparing the foundations, sub-structure and external works for the new campus. The superstructure modules were in position in February 2023 and works on site will continue throughout the summer.

Creating a 900sqm facility on remediated land along West Bromwich High Street, the new Sandwell MEC centre will encompass new technologies to deliver a range of academic, vocational and apprenticeship courses. These will cover areas of skills shortage including engineering, construction and advanced manufacturing, as well as addressing other areas of demand for higher and advanced level skills and qualifications.

The modular build campus is expected to open in

Town Hall Quarter

The West Bromwich Town Hall Quarter Project has received funding from Governments Towns Fund Programme to restore and renovate the Grade II listed West Bromwich Town Hall and Central Library buildings, internally and externally as well as providing a new Equalities Act compliant entrance from West Bromwich High Street.

Over the last 12 months, works form the earlier Accelerated funding element of the Project has enabled refurbishment works to take place on the Bell Tower which has now been completed. Scaffolding works started in April and will continue over the next few weeks. This will enable the contractors to undertake the preliminary works, surveys and additional investigations throughout summer to detail the complete package of restoration works required. During this period the Central Library will remain open as normal.

Restoration works are planned to start in Sept 2023 and once completed, will help transform the Town Hall and Central Library (built in 1907) into a modern and vibrant facility to benefit local people and community groups and third sector organisations.


