The T Level Roadshow saw Sandwell College take their big Americanstyle yellow bus out on the road to visit a range of secondary schools across the Black Country and Birmingham.

The roadshow was in celebration of National T Levels Week and provided school pupils with the chance to hop aboard, meet expert staff, and hear about some of the fabulous employers working with the College to offer T Level placements.

They also experienced a taste of industry immersion with a range of 'have a go' activities, such as:

- digital area mapping and basic block coding with a robot dog – for young people interested in Construction & Digital courses
- exploring physiology and human anatomy with iPads and Merge Cubes – for learners interested in Health T Levels
- VR nursery simulation, plus an immersive sensory programme – for pupils interested in Education and Early Years careers

School Liaison and expert teaching staff met thousands of young people across the week and explained more about the College's latest multi-million investments into brand-new engineering and health facilities at the West Bromwich STEM Centre and the Midland Metropolitan

University Hospital Learning Campus which are set to open in early 2026.

Event were also hosted on campus with a Careers in Media and Broadcast talk by BBC presenter and producer Trish Adudu; a workplace readiness session hosted by partner employer HydraPower dynamics; Q&As with Lloyds Banking Group on life inside a top UK bank; and a 'skills in action' showcase with T Level Media students capturing content for a college social media takeover.

Sandwell College has been expanding its T Level provision since 2023 to offer a highly varied range, including Digital Software Development, Health, Education & Early Years (Childcare), Engineering, Business Management and Cyber Security.

T Level students at Sandwell College have achieved amazing results, including Distinction grades for all Digital students in the summer. Many have now gone on to university or directly into the workplace or a higher-level apprenticeship.

West Bromwich Town Deal Programme

Two major projects at the heart of the town centre redevelopment are moving ahead, bringing new opportunities for local traders and improved public spaces. Both projects are supported by the government's Towns Fund programme.

Indoor Market development

The new market is located on High Street and replaces the old indoor market in Kings Square.

This is one of the centrepieces of Sandwell Council's West Bromwich Masterplan, created to deliver a modern and vibrant destination for both traders and shoppers. Combining traditional market stalls with contemporary facilities, the market also features specialist street food in the new food court.

During the opening two weeks, 77,627 people visited the new market!

The market includes the return of Firkins Bakery, plus a butcher, fishmonger, Caribbean food supplies, beauty services, cosmetics and perfume, curtains, mobile phone repairs,



as well as clothes, haberdashery and pet food supplies.

A new food court offers diverse cuisines including East Asian, Sri Lankan, Caribbean, hot pork sandwiches, an instore bakery and freshly made doughnuts.

The project is a great example of collaboration thanks to £2.61million funding from the government's Towns Fund programme, which is supporting regeneration and investment in towns across the country, and £2.03m funding from Sandwell Council.




2025 Footfall Figures



Current local policing priorities

COVID-19 | Under-25 Violence | Domestic Abuse





Inspector for the north sector of Sandwell, where I manage the officers who cover the areas of Great Barr & Newton, Tipton, Wednesbury and West Bromwich. I have a real passion for neighbourhood policing and come from a neighbourhood background, having been a sergeant and temporary Inspector over the last two years in Washwood Heath, Birmingham.

My passion for local policing comes from wanting to make a difference and influence individuals on a grass root level, whilst working with partners and the community. Having started in Sandwell as a student officer 10 years ago, it makes me proud to come back to the Local Policing Area where I learnt the basics.

Over the last year, I was leading on Operation Elevate (clear, hold, build), where I led on a partnership approach to tackling serious organised crime and issues that mattered to the communities of Alum Rock. It fills me with pride to say that we reduced overall crime by 17% and serious youth violence by 38%, with my biggest achievement being setting up the first women's Street Watch group in the West Midlands.

Moving to Sandwell means that I can bring new ideas and challenge unchanged practices to improve our performance and the way we operate as neighbourhood officers. I am keen to continue to meet partners and community members to understand how we can work together to improve the service to our communities.

Outside of work, I am keen to head out for a run, go to the gym and as a father to an 11-monthold, create memories with my family. I have been a school governor, a mentor and assessor for local and national police recruitment processes as well as supporting the West Midlands Police Black & Asian Police Association, things which I have done in my spare time to give back to others.


